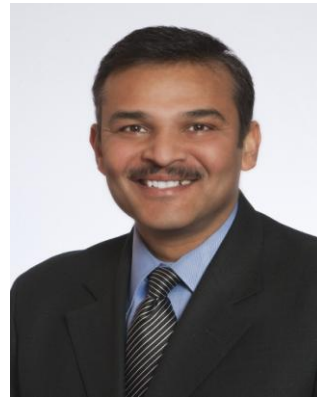


Sunil K. Sinha, MD, MBA
