Dr. Turner has been practicing Allergy and Clinical Immunology for over 20 years. She currently practices with Virginia Adult and Pediatric Allergy and Asthma. Her medical degree was from Medical College of Pennsylvania, where she graduated in the upper quarter of her class. Her internship was in Internal Medicine at Michael Reese Hospital, affiliated with University of Chicago. Two years of residency in Internal Medicine followed at the Cleveland Clinic in Cleveland, OH. Her Fellowship in Allergy and Clinical Immunology was at Northwestern University Medical Center under Dr. Roy Patterson. She is Board Certified by the American Board of Internal Medicine and the American Board of Allergy and Clinical Immunology. She is a Fellow of the American College of Physicians, and a Fellow of the American Academy of Allergy, Asthma and Immunology, and a member of the Virginia Allergy Society and the Richmond Academy of Medicine. She has held faculty appointments at Northwestern, Rush, Cornell and MCV medical schools and has published in the areas of treating asthma during pregnancy, occupational lung disease, reactions to iodinated contrast media, and on the diagnosis of Allergic Bronchopulmonary Aspergillosis in children. One of her publications, a review on management of asthma during pregnancy published in Annals of Internal Medicine, was considered a landmark article and listed up to 4 years later in Annals "Annotated Bibliography of Recent Literature" in the subject area.
